

Mathematical problems (1)

1, In CP, there're thirteen boys and twelve girls.
How many people are there in CP ?

$$\text{Calculation : } 13 + 12 = 25$$

Answer : in CP, there're twenty-five people.

2, In CE1, there're twenty-six pupils and one teacher.
How many people are there in CE1 ?

$$\text{Calculation : } 26 + 1 = 27$$

Answer : in CE1, there're twenty-seven people.

3, In CE2, there're twenty-four pupils and two teachers.
How many people are there in CE2 ?

$$\text{Calculation : } 24 + 2 = 26$$

Answer : in CE2, there're twenty-six people.

4, In CM2, there're twenty-seven people. There're thirteen boys.
How many girls are there in CM2 ?

$$\text{Calculation : } 27 - 13 = 14$$

Answer : in CM2, there're fourteen girls.
